Unfortunately, we don't have budget to reimburse you the expenses made for the things that you are bringing, but try to be creative and funny! You can bring typical costumes, ornaments, leaflets, posters, flyers, food, sweets...
- ✓ Spread the Culture For activities, you can bring with you: traditional games from your country or region, photos, cultural objects from your region/town videos, music only for the Intercultural exhibition evening...

Insurance

Personal and medical insurance are the responsibility of the individual participant. We will not be responsible for any loss of luggage, currency or personal effects, or any medical costs.

We suggest that each participants bring the European Sanitary Card in order to be safe in case of emergency.

Concerning the non EU countries, we suggest you to buy an insurance for travel, the INSURANCE IS MANDATORY, but we suggest you to buy it.

Travel

The closest Airport is: **ORIO AL SERIO in Bergamo** (Milano BGY) - www. orioaeroporto.it Other suitable airports are **Verona airport**, **Milano Linate** or **Milano Malpensa**.

From these Airports to Manerba d/G you have to:

- take the shuttle from the airport (from each airport there area shuttles each 20 minuts) to the main train station (http://www.trenitalia.com/)

- take the train with destination **DESENZANO DEL GARDA**.

We will organise a transport to pick you up at the train station of Desenzano del Garda.

Travel reimbursement

Travel costs will be covered, based on the country of participants, up to foreseen limits. The exact amount written on the ticket will be accepted. Travels should be by economy class and public transport.

We will refund travel tickets based on actual costs incurred and on presentation of: Invoice of the plane ticket; Boarding Pass with the clear mention of the passenger; All other transportation-related bills.

Please note: Sending organizations are responsible to collect all participants travel documents and present it well organized to Hosting Organization for travel reimbursement. Please keep in mind that reimbursement will be done with one transfer after the project (not an individual transfers).

What to bring with you
